Summary of Regulations

The full Harpole's Heartland Lodge, Inc. Regulations are provided at check-in and control all activities on the ORV course.

- Parking and Unloading:** West Side of arena in area A or in front of hay barn in area E.
- Riding Not Allowed:** Guests bringing their own ATV are not allowed to ride past the ATV sign located at the end of the ATV parking lot in area A. Lodge area is kept quiet.
- Boundaries:** Ride within our boundaries.
- Public Roadways:** Illegal by State law (prohibited).
DO NOT LEAVE OUR PROPERTY.
- Grass:** ATVs are not allowed near Lodges. Please stay off all grass and food plots.
- Horses:** Stop and idle down. Horses have the Right of Way.
- Hours:** 9:00 AM-Dark (personal ATV on Original Park)
9:00 AM-5PM (Lodge ATV & safe passage, & Area D)
- Alcohol and Smoking:** Operation of an ATV while under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited on the Lodge property. Alcohol is not permitted on the ATV trails. DO NOT LITTER. Place trash and CIGARETTE BUTTS in the trash containers located through the lodge property.
- Equipment:** Helmets must be worn at all times when riding Lodge rented ATVs. The use of helmets while riding guest ATVs is strongly recommended.
- Weather:** Sudden Storms can cause creeks to rise and lightening strikes. Return to lodge ASAP!
- Service Call:** \$25 service call to retrieve or assistance to get any ATV. Charge every 60 minutes.
- Warning:** All Users of facilities and property do so at their own risk.
- Releases:** Lodge is released from Liability; you are responsible for any damages to our equipment or land.
- All Lodge rented ATVs must be operated by only one rider at a time. No passengers are permitted. Two riders are permitted on guest ATVs consistent with the manufacturer's safety guidelines, instructions and weight restrictions.
- All ATVs operated on the Lodge property must be operated in a safe and responsible manner. Jumps, stunts, bumping, cutting in front of other riders, or other unsafe acts are prohibited at all times.
- Speed Limits:**
Within parking and camping areas five (5) MPH.
Safe passage (5) MPH.
Trails (20) MPH.
Main road on original ATV park(30) MPH.

Unreasonable speeds can cause injury.

Ride within your ability and conditions.



Information:

- All riders must check in at our Prairie Ridge lodge before riding.
- Maps of the ATV trails are provided when checking in.
- Bring extra gas and supplies.
- Local car washes are available in Nebo and Pleasant Hill.
- ORVs and bikes are welcome.
- Ice is available at the resort.
- Soda and food vending machines are available to all riders.
