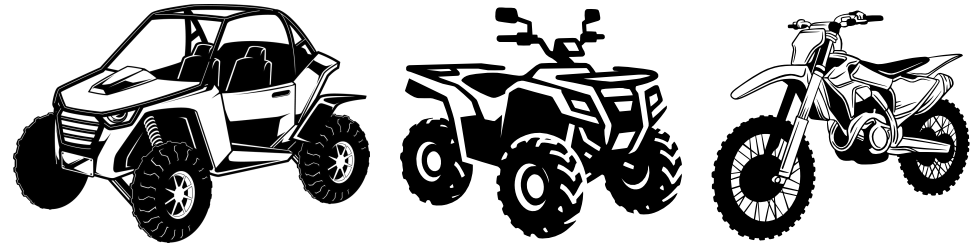

OHV Park Regulations

- Parking and Unloading: West side of Corral or behind hay barn.
- Riding Not Allowed: Guests bringing their own ATV are not allowed to ride past the ATV sign located at the end of the ATV parking lot. Lodge area is kept quiet.
- Boundaries: Ride within our boundaries.
- Public Roadways: NO RIDING- Illegal by State law (prohibited).
- DO NOT LEAVE OUR PROPERTY.
- Grass: ATVs are not allowed near Lodges. Please stay off all grass and food plots.
- Hours: 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM (personal ATV)
- 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM (Lodge Rental UTV)
- Alcohol and Smoking: Consumption of alcohol is prohibited on any trails on Lodge property. Operation of an ATV while under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited on the Lodge property.
- Rental Rules: No Riding on ATV Timber Trails
- No Donuts, No Excessive Speed, Hands Inside at All Times, Seat Belt, Helmet & Eye Protection On Stay Off Yards & Public Roads Stay Out of All Mudholes/Ponds
- For any UTV Polaris Rental Damages = \$1,500
- Weather: Sudden Storms can cause creeks to rise and lightening strikes. Return to lodge ASAP!
- Service Call: The Lodge charges \$150 for the first hour, plus \$50 per hour for any time beyond that, for any service call to retrieve or assistance to get any ATV.
- Warning: All Users of facilities and property do so at their own risk.
- Releases: Lodge is released from Liability; you are responsible for any damages to our equipment or land.
- Quiet Hours: 10:00 PM - Brunch
- All ATV / UTV must be operated by manufacturers recommendations.
- All ATVs operated on the Lodge property must be operated in a safe and responsible manner. Jumps, stunts, bumping, cutting in front of other riders, or other unsafe acts are prohibited at all times.
- Speed Limits:
 - Within parking and camping areas five (5) MPH.
 - Safe passage (15) MPH.
 - Trails (20) MPH.
 - Main road on original ATV parking (35) MPH.
- If in doubt Back Out!
- Unreasonable speeds can cause injury. Ride within your ability and conditions.

- All riders must check in at our Prairie Ridge lodge before riding.
- Maps of the ATV trails are provided when checking in.
- Bring extra gas and supplies.
- Local car washes are available in Nebo and Pleasant Hill.
- ATV, UTV and Dirt Bikes are welcome.
- All users of facilities and properties do so at your own risk.
- All riders must sign a waiver and rules form.
